



For-Bid™ TREAT COPROPHAGIA IN ANIMALS

For-Bid is a top selling, vet recommended coprophagia (stool eating) deterrent for over 40 years. For-Bid™ is a highly purified crystalline edible protein fraction, which when mixed with food and fed to an animal may curb coprophagia. For-Bid™ is not an enzyme mixture which alters the normal endogenous digestive process. Sprinkling the powder on food, which is then consumed by the animal, will yield a unpalatable taste to feces.

- For-Bid is used to stop stool eating by dogs, cats and other animals
- Simply add to the pet's food
- Makes stool unappetizing
- Animal learns that stool is not for consumption and the coprophagia habit should stop.



Coprophagia is the behavior in which animals consume their own stool or the stool of other animals. Coprophagia is quite common in animals and is generally viewed as a bad habit. The longer an animal has been eating stool, the harder it can be to stop.

Coprophagia may result from a variety of factors including but not limited to:

- Curiosity
- Attention seeking
- Boredom or lack of exercise
- Modeling of other animals
- Access to stool in house or yard



When a dog is eating another dog's stool or out of a cat's litter box, feed For-Bid™ to all animals involved as directed above.

Tips for success:

- Be sure you are not overfeeding your animal
- Always keep fresh water available to help aid digestion
- Continue to clean up after your pet
- Consult your vet to come up with a treatment plan

Directions: Administer by sprinkling on the animal's food as recommended. If using dry food, it is recommended to moisten food with water before adding. Be sure the animal is not on steroids, as this will counter the effect of For-Bid™.
